4. Do you consider yourself to have been physically or sexually abused as a child? (This information will be kept entirely confidential. We realize it can be very hard to process abuse, especially on your own, and we would like to offer ourselves in any way we can, even if just to listen or talk.)

5. Have you ever physically or sexually abused a child?

6. Has someone ever accused you of abusing a child?

7. Have you (or do you) ever feel at conflict with CRB's understanding of biblical sexual ethics? (Here's a refresher on that...We believe that every person is created in the image of God and is deserving of respect because of that alone. We believe that every person is created either male or female. We believe that God ordains one man for one woman in a covenantal union called marriage. We believe that both the male and the female reflect unique characteristics of God and that together they reflect God's fullness more accurately. We believe that all sexual activity outside of marriage is sinful. We believe that homosexual activity is sinful but no different than other sexual sin.)

8. Tell me about your relationship with God. How has it been since camp ended? What have you done to build a stronger relationship with Him?

9. With what hard things in life are you wrestling with God? (It's OK to wrestle with God.)

10. Where are you currently attending church? Tell me about your involvement.

11. In what ways has your faith affected your life in practical ways since you left camp in August?

12. Are you dating anyone? Are you thinking about starting a relationship with someone? If so, please tell me about that person. Are you sure this person is a Christian? How?

13. Can you commit to being at Camp Ray Bird for the entire summer (dates on p. 1)? Please list any requests for time off and the reason for the request. Whenever possible, requests for time off need to be made before the beginning of the summer.
